

Renihan Meadows Fire Pit / Chiminea Rules

To ensure the safety of all residents of Renihan Meadows the following rules must be adhered to when using wood burning fire pits and chimineas.

1. A burn permit must be secured from the Lebanon Fire Department. A one day or multiple day permit can be obtained.
2. A call must be placed to the Lebanon Fire Department prior to lighting the fire to ensure it is safe to have a fire that day and again when the fire is extinguished. No exceptions.
3. The fire must be 15 feet away from any structure.
4. Only seasoned wood to be used and no wood from pine trees or wood that is damp. It is recommended that people use firelogs as they are long burning and don't give off sparks. Screens to minimize sparks must be used.
5. Sunday thru Thursday fires must be extinguished by 7 pm. Friday and Saturday and all days that fall before a Federal Holiday the fires must be extinguished by 10:30 pm.
5. A five (5) gallon bucket of water must be within three feet of the fire at all times in case sparks fly and to put out the fire.
6. An adult 18 years or older must attend to the fire at all times until the fire has been extinguished.

Violations of the above rules will lead to fines and / or suspension of said privilege.

Note 1. Wood burning fire pits and chimeneas will be banned for use starting the fall of 2022. Therefore, if you are considering buying one in the future it is highly recommended that you purchase a propane one.
